The University of California (UC), Davis, School of Medicine seeks to hire a full-time Hematopathologist at the Assistant/Associate level in the Clinical (X) or the Health Sciences Clinical Professor Series in the Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine. This position is an academic physician- educator/investigator to grow clinical, teaching and creative programs in hematopathology. Training and expertise in lymphoma diagnosis, molecular pathology and coagulation is highly desirable. Clinical duties will primarily involve hematopathology and clinical hematology/coagulation services. Service assignments in surgical pathology or other areas of the clinical laboratory may also be possible based on training and experience. Teaching duties will include clinical, didactic, and small group teaching of housestaff and medical students, interdisciplinary conferences to housestaff and faculty, and curriculum development in subspecialty areas. Participation in the research mission of the institution is expected, either as a collaborator or as the intellectual leader of clinically-oriented research projects pertinent to the candidate's areas of expertise and subspecialty training, depending on academic series chosen for appointment.
