The Nisqually Tribe is an American Indian nation in western [Washington State](#). The tribe resides on a reservation in the Nisqually River valley near the river delta. The reservation is adjacent to the Fort Lewis Military Reserve and situated on the lower Nisqually River east of Olympia. The Lushootseed language, which is the traditional tongue of the Nisqually and neighboring tribes, is a subgroup of the Salishan family of Native American languages.

Tribal Health Administrator -The Tribal Health Administrator is responsible for providing leadership and oversight of effective health care programs specifically designed to meet the needs of the Tribe and community. This position oversees clinic operations and all other health related programs and services. The Nisqually Tribal Health Administrator is expected to operate in a professional and business-like (net-profit) manner. This position ensures maximization of revenue streams and third party reimbursements

- Evaluate, diagnose, and treat medical and surgical diseases and emergencies for men, women, and children under the direct supervision of a physician.
- Provide direct, unsupervised treatment of minor/routine medical conditions.
- Perform histories, physicals, evaluations, and diagnosis of patients.
- Perform excisions, biopsies, incision and drainage, laceration repairs and additional minor office procedures in accordance with training.
- Provide and coordinate comprehensive care for assigned patients in any assigned care setting and in accordance with training and education.
