Candidates must have an MD or DO degree and be licensed or be eligible for licensure by the California Medical Board, and must have completed residency training in comprehensive ophthalmology or neurology followed by fellowship training in neuro-ophthalmology. Demonstrated capabilities for teaching and professional service are required. Duties will include excellent patient care in addition to sharing in the responsibility for didactic and clinical training of fellows, residents, and medical students. Research is not a mandatory requirement for this position; however, the department encourages research and/or creative activity.
