

The Indian Health Service (IHS) is seeking physicians, nurses, and respiratory therapists for a rapid response deployment pool to aid IHS facilities as needs demand.

Volunteers must be prepared for rapid deployment and to participate in a backup pool. Volunteer commitment is a maximum of 2 weeks per month.

Deployed clinicians will receive:

- *Flexible scheduling
- *Per diem and lodging
- *Generous honoraria
- *Logistical and clinical support including tele-critical care consult
- *Appropriate personal protective equipment and necessary supplies

Physician, nurse, and respiratory therapist volunteers must have BLS, ACLS, or PALS qualifications and hold a current license in any of the 50 United States to qualify.

Physician volunteers must have graduated from an Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME)-certified allopathic/osteopathic program or have Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates (ECFMG) certification.
