This individual, appointed at the Associate or Full Professor level, will be responsible for strategic leadership and direction for all aspects of the clinical, educational, research and other programmatic missions of the Department located at Banner - University Medical Center -Phoenix.

The Chair will lead a team of radiologists, ancillary staff and personnel and will be responsible for expanding the program. Specific needs and opportunities include recruiting faculty members particularly with expertise in interventional and diagnostic radiology, building clinical programs, and evolving clinical investigation. An additional goal will be the development of a GME training program in partnership with the Phoenix Veterans Administration Medical Center.

This position reports directly to the Dean, College of Medicine – Phoenix for all academic activities. Consistent with the Academic Affiliation Agreement (AAA) between the University of Arizona and Banner Health, the Department Chair will have a matrix reporting relationship to the Chief Executive Officer of the Banner-University Medical Group (B-UMG) and CEO of B-UMC (Phoenix) for all clinical activities conducted at Banner-University Medical Center (Phoenix).
