We are pleased to announce that LeeAnna Muzquiz, M.D. has agreed to serve as Assistant Dean for Admissions for the UW School of Medicine beginning September 1, 2017 and will assume the position of Associate Dean for Admissions in July 2018 upon the retirement of Carol Teitz, M.D.

Dr. Muzquiz graduated from UWSOM in 2000 and received a Native American Center of Excellence Certificate for successful completion of the Indian Health Pathway. She completed her residency at the Seattle Indian Health Board Clinic through the Swedish Family Medicine Residency Program in Seattle, and was chief resident from 2002 to 2003. Dr. Muzquiz also received certification from the Montana Medical Association for successfully completing its Physician Leadership Effectiveness Program in 2016.

Dr. Muzquiz has taught medical students and physician assistant students for UWSOM for the past 12 years. She served on the Montana WWAMI Admissions Committee for many years and has held many national leadership roles in medical education.

Born in Omak, Washington, Dr. Muzquiz has tribal citizenship with the Confederated Salish & Kootenai Tribes (CSKT) of the Flathead Reservation in Montana. She has worked as a family physician with the CSKT since 2003 and in 2011 became the medical director for CSKT Tribal Health. She will maintain her Montana residence, traveling to UWSOM as needed, and will continue to see patients at the Tribal Health Center in Polson.

Dr. Muzquiz brings outstanding knowledge and skills to her new role. Please join us in welcoming her.
