Clinical practice is located at the Allina Health United Family Physicians Clinic and United Hospital in St. Paul, Minnesota.

Principle Responsibilities

- Provides direct patient care for patients of all ages.
- Supervises and teaches residents and medical students in the ambulatory and inpatient environments.
- Participates in faculty hospital on-call rotation.
- Provides didactic presentations, case discussions and procedural training.
- Serves as a faculty advisor for residents.
- Participates in quality improvement teams, work groups and committees
- Content leader for designated areas of the residency program curriculum.
- Engages in scholarly activities as defined by the ACGME and promotes scholarly opportunities for residents.
- **FM Faculty with OB:**
 - Performs and supervises prenatal care, labor management and deliveries.
 - Participates in OB/pediatric inpatient faculty on-call rotation.
- **FM Faculty without OB:**
 - Supervises and teaches residents and medical students in the nursing home.

Job Requirements

- M.D./D.O. or the equivalent medical degree
- Completion of an ACGME-accredited residency in Family Medicine
- Medical licensure in Minnesota or able to obtain
- ABFM Board certification
- Demonstrated excellence in patient care including ambulatory practice and hospital medicine
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching residents and medical students
- Two or more year of clinical practice and professional teaching experience preferred
- **FM Faculty with OB:** Expertise and recent experience providing prenatal care, labor management and deliveries
- **FM Faculty without OB:** Geriatric and nursing home experience preferred

We are based at United Hospital, a 400-bed acute care hospital where we are the only sponsored residency.
