Criteria for the Professor of Clinical X Series:

The incumbent will be expected to teach fellows, residents, and medical students; clinical research/ creative activity; provide clinical patient care; contribute to scholarly activities; and provide public and University service.

Qualifications:

Candidates must possess an M.D. or M.D./Ph.D., board certification or board eligibility in Plastic Surgery, and California Medical License edibility is required.

Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with training, qualifications, and experience. Strong interest and demonstrated abilities in delivering patient care in an academic clinical setting, teaching residents and medical students, and providing service to the University are required.
