Hennepin Healthcare is an integrated system of care that includes HCMC, a nationally recognized Level I Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center and acute care hospital. The comprehensive healthcare system includes a 484 bed academic medical center, a multi-specialty outpatient Clinic & Specialty Center, and a network of primary and specialty care clinics in Minneapolis and in suburban communities in Hennepin County.

Our women's health clinic offers full spectrum obstetric and gynecologic care to women and LGBTQ individuals for many conditions including high risk pregnancy, prenatal diagnosis, genetic counseling, endometriosis, fibroids, incontinence and pelvic organ prolapse, as well as gynecologic surgery. We offer advanced ultrasound under the direction of our maternal fetal medicine specialists and can assist patients in accessing doula care, pelvic floor physical therapy, lactation support, acupuncture and other integrative health practices, as well as minimally invasive procedures within the health system.

We recognize the critical impact of mental health on new parents and families. We are proud to collaborate with embedded psychiatry providers in our clinic as well as the Mother-Baby program, as part of the Redleaf Center for Family Healing, which offers a range of multi-generation, trauma-informed mental health services to support pregnant individuals and families with children ages newborn to 5 years old.
