Applicants should be known and respected within their profession, both nationally and internationally, as individuals of outstanding scientific competence. Applicants should have the demonstrated ability to manage financial and human resources, including supervisory experience. Applicants must submit a current curriculum vitae, a copy of degree, bibliography, and full contact details for three references. Appointees may be a US citizen, Legal Permanent Resident or non-US citizen who are eligible for a valid work authorization.
